

V.F.W. POST HERE NAMED FOR GENERAL ATTERBURY

The Pennsylvania Railroad employees' post of the Veterans of Foreign Wars was started last night under the name of the General W. W. Atterbury Post 3420, in honor of the late president of the railroad, who died this year.

Permission to use General Atterbury's name was granted the post by his widow, who lives in Philadelphia. This was announced at a meeting last night in the auditorium of the Pennsylvania Railroad.

Permanent officers will be elected at a meeting at the same place December 10 and it is likely installation will be held December 20. Among the members are Colonel H. H. Maxfield, superintendent of motive power, who commanded the Nineteenth Railway Engineers in France during the World War, and Master Mechanic C. K. Steins, who was also with the Nineteenth Engineers.
