

New V. F. W. Post Named for Sailor Killed at Anzio

A 21-year-old Wilmingtonian in the Navy, killed in action at the Anzio Beachhead, who said in a letter home that it was his ambition to become commander of a Veterans of Foreign Wars post, last night achieved a greater honor—a new V. F. W. post was named in his memory.

The name, Joseph A. Iannelli Post, V. F. W. was selected at a meeting last night at St. Anthony's School, preliminary to organization of the post which is being formed in the neighborhood of St. Anthony's Catholic Church, Ninth and DuPont Streets. Seaman First Class Iannelli, son of Mr. and Mrs. Victor Iannelli, 2512 West Fourth Street, was a member of St. Anthony's Parish. He was named for his uncle, Joseph A. Iannelli, 524 West Fourth Street, a former commander of Admiral Samuel F. duPont Post, V. F. W., this city.

Those attending the preliminary meeting also proposed that the Very Rev. Dr. J. Francis Tucker, O. S. F. S., pastor of St. Anthony's Church, who served overseas as a chaplain of an artillery regiment in the A. E. F., be nominated to be the
